Success in school involves being able to complete work, stay organized, get along with kids and adults, be positive about your own abilities and school, follow rules...and do your best work! Most kids with disabilities (and many kids without disabilities) have trouble with one or more of those skills. The result is often behavior problems. Sometimes problem behaviors show up at home, too.

This workshop will provide specific strategies for dealing with common (and some not-so-common) behavior issues. Whether the problem is related to sensory issues, academic or social needs, or organizational skills such as completing assignments, the process will work for any kid!

Beginning with a brief overview of Positive Behavior Supports, because that is the framework for changing problem behavior, practitioners (teachers and specialists) will share success stories from actual classroom experiences. Participants will receive information and resources to assist in developing a plan for **any** child.
